**IMPORTANT CAMPING REMINDERS!

It's great fun to forage around the campsite for pinecones, pebbles, feathers, flowers, sticks. But some sites and parks don't allow campfires AND/OR picking things such as wildflowers or taking rocks home or even certain bird feathers, such as bald eagle feathers. Check with the park or campsite rules for where you are staying to make sure the area allows campers/hikers to remove rocks and other treasures. If not, remember to leave those treasures untouched or left behind for the next campers to admire. Not all plants, flowers, and berries are touchable either. Some are poisonous!
