

Tall Crowns

You will need:

- Paper tubes (toilet paper tubes work great!)
- Scissors
- Craft paint
- Miscellaneous decorations (pom-poms, jewels, glitter, sequins, silk daisies, etc.)
- Glue
- Rope elastic or stiff plastic headband

1. Snip the tubes according to the photos. You will end up with approx 6 points to the crown.



2. Paint the outer and inner sides of the crown. Pink, green, purple, blue...metallics are nice too!

3. When paint is dry, decorate with pom-poms, glitter, jewels. Tacky brand glue dries fast.
4. There are two ways to make the crown wearable.
 - a. Poke a small hole on either side of crown. Knot rope elastic on one end. Thread through to the other side. Adjust for sizing on child's head. Knot the other side.
 - b. On the non pointy side of the crown, paper punch two holes on either side of crown, large enough to slide through a narrow plastic headband. Carefully slide the crown to the side or center.
